
Mottainai Kan (288 Niisato)

**◀ Fee ▶**

The disposal fee is charged per household based on the monthly total weight (as of the end of each month) of waste directly delivered to the three facilities: Tatebayashi Clean Center, Tatebayashi Waste Storage Yard, and Itakura Recycling Center. Refer to the table below for details.


◇ Fee table (for reference)

Total disposed weight	Fee charged (yen)
10 ~ 90 kg	0 yen
100 kg	2,000yen + (Tax)
110 kg	2,200yen + (Tax)
120 kg	2,400yen + (Tax)

※ When the monthly total weight becomes 100 kg or more, the fee of 200 yen plus tax per 10 kg will be charged.
